



HOW TO FIND US:

From Winsford

Take the A54, Delamere Street from Winsford towards Kelsall. At Salterswall bear right towards Whitegate and Sandiway. Take the right fork at Marton. Turn right onto Cinder Hill. Then turn right just before the church on the left-hand side into Grange Lane leading onto Mill Lane. Continue on Mill Lane for approx. 1 mile until you reach Riverside Park.

From Northwich

At the Sandiway traffic lights on the A556 turn left follow Dalesford Lane, turn left for Whitegate onto Cinder Hill. Then turn right just before the church on the left-hand side into Grange Lane leading onto Mill Lane. Continue on Mill Lane for approx. 1 mile until you reach Riverside Park.
